1. A written statement of intent

2. A statement of your financial situation and how it relates to your continuing educational goals include any contribution from other resources

3. A resume of community service/activities (including approximate number of hours spent with each activity), honors and awards received, and work experience.

4. At least two letters of recommendation

One can be from a recent employer, mentor, or someone under whose direction you have worked on a volunteer basis. Ask the writer to be specific about your accomplishments, your seriousness of purpose, and your character.

5. Why should you be considered for this scholarship and what makes you a better candidate for this opportunity.

6. Optionally, to enhance your application, you may also submit up to two essays, each 150 to 200 words in length on the following subjects:

A. How are you living by the principle of the Rotary 4-Way Test (see the attached explanation) within your family and your community,

B. Select one of the following character traits and describe how you have demonstrated that trait in the last year.

Courage, responsibility, respect, kindness, self control, perseverance,
honesty, courtesy
