Dear Scholarship Counselor,

The Whidbey Island Chapter of the Military Officers Association of America (WICMOAA) sponsors one \$3,000 scholarships for graduating seniors from eligible area high schools. WICMOAA has members from Whidbey Island, Fidalgo Island, Arlington, and the Burlington/Mt. Vernon area.

Eligibility for the WICMOAA scholarship is as follows:

Applicant must be enrolled in a high school JROTC program or be a military dependent currently enrolled in an eligible high school.

Applicant must have been accepted for admission to a four-year college.

Applicant must be nominated by one of their high school teachers.

A student accepting a college ROTC scholarship or admitted to a military service academy is not eligible.

Students will be evaluated on academic performance, leadership skills, education goals, extra-curricular activity, and financial need.

The enclosed application form should be completed and returned to the address in the letterhead by 4 April 2019. The form may be duplicated in the event you have more than one applicant. We expect to finalize the awardee selections by the end of April 2019 and would like to present the awards at an appropriate school assembly.

The Military Officers Association of America also provides grants and interest-free loans to children from military families pursuing their first undergraduate degree.
